Mordechai heard the men at the gate plotting to kill the king

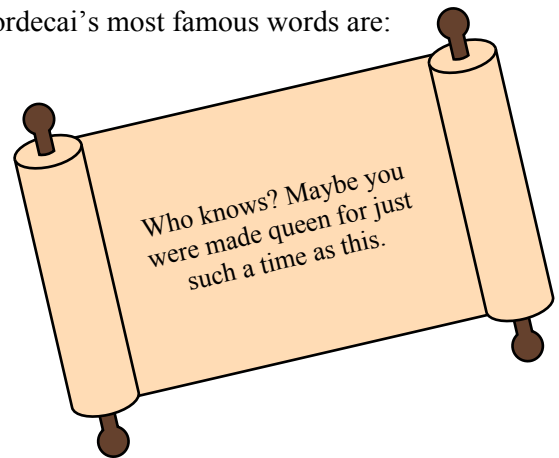
Mordechai send a message to Ester to tell the king

bowing to him

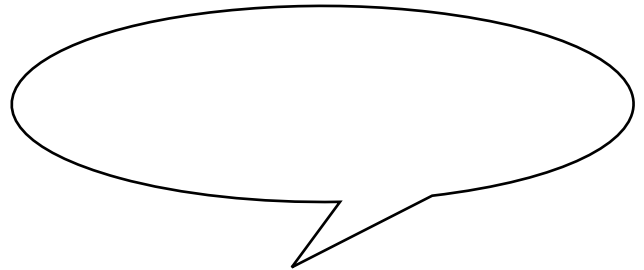
Haman convinced the king to help him kill all the
