Samson was a Nazirite, but he had broken the Nazirite promises -

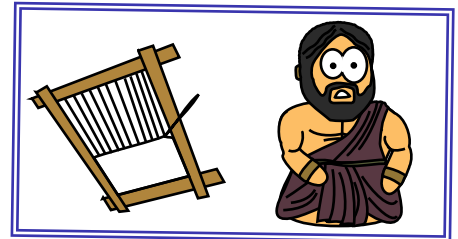
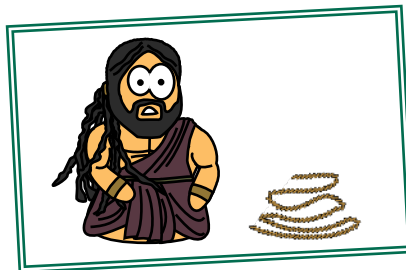
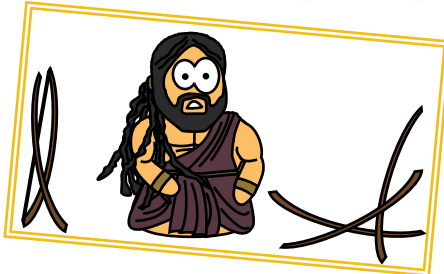

Samson had had made some bad decisions and trusted the wrong person. Samson pretended to tell Delilah the secret of his strength 3 times, complete the pictures for each



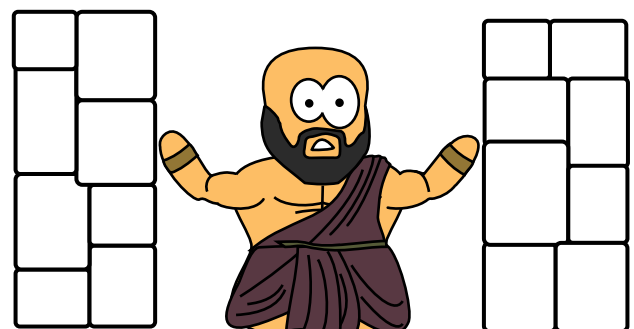
Cross out the wrong word :
