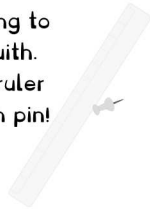

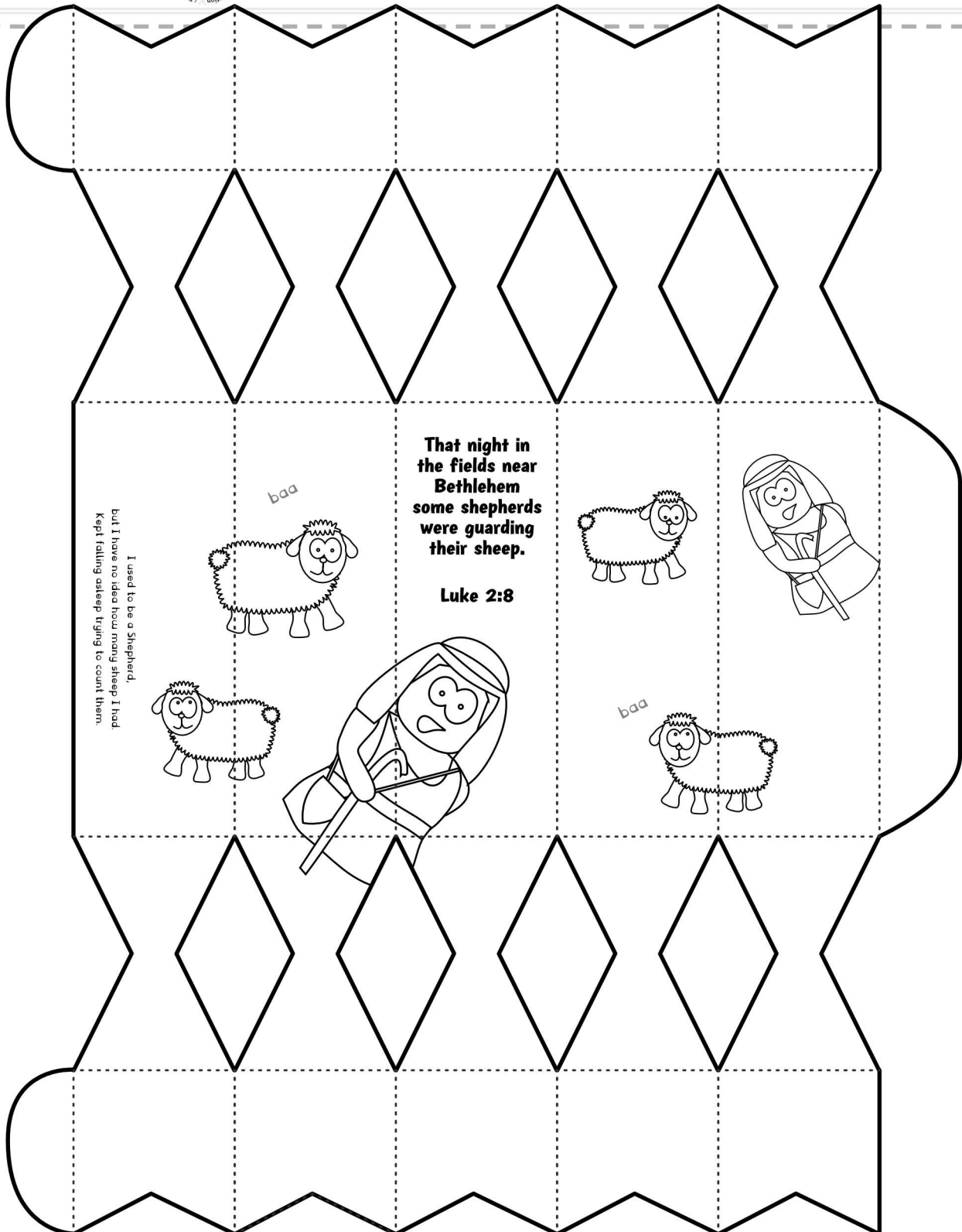
## Instructions
